## Update for Board of Selectmen/Town Council May 2018

Good evening, I am here tonight as your appointed representative to the Cape Light Compact JPE Governing Board to give you and those watching your meeting a brief update on a few timely items.

- First, for a limited time Cape Light Compact is doubling the incentive to recycle a Refrigerator and Freezer. Customers who have a working residential size fridge or freezer can schedule a free pick-up by calling 877-889-4761, and have it properly recycled. Customers who call this number between May 14 and June 15 will receive a \$100 rebate (instead of the standard \$50 offer), in addition to free-pick up. Additional information about this offer can be found on the Compact's web site.
- Second, the Compact will once again be offering its successful Dehumidifier Turn-In event on June 9<sup>th</sup> in East Falmouth and June 16<sup>th</sup> in Orleans. Both events will be held in partnership with Crane Appliance. Customers can drop-off their old dehumidifier free of charge and receive a \$30 rebate. There is a limit of 2 turn-ins per residential electric account. Additional information about this offer can be found on the Compact's web site.

• Finally, I wanted to let you know that the Compact's participation in the Eversource Rate case, which was approved by the MA Department of Public Utilities in January, resulted in approximately \$8M in savings to southeastern Massachusetts electric customers, including the Cape and Vineyard, in 2018. The savings relates to transition charge consolidation.
