The most challenging and most rewarding of these applications was the Squibmocket Farms proposal to build a causeway. There was diligence and consideration that was respectful and thorough by both the applicants and the Commision over the course of many months, and this resulted in a plan that restored a town beach the way nature meant it to be and a well engineered causeway that will ensure safe access to Squibnocket Point for many years.

This past year under the Chairmanship of Candy Shweder the Commission put together a flyer which explains the mission of the Con Comm and information that homeowners and businesses need to know when developing a project. This is a first step at educating the general population of Chilmark about the importance of being responsible stewards of our fragile land here. I believe we can do more in this direction.
