Tim,

We met on Thursday, June 28th to hear the report of the Town's consultant relative to site suitability. While the plan looked like it would work, it required the creation of a building envelope closer than is normally allowed to wet lands—a possible no-go condition for the Conservation Commission.

It was our strong recommendation that the Selectmen resume their efforts to acquire the Carroll property in order both to create better alternatives for the Emergency Responder building and generally give the Town more flexibility as it responds to future needs.

I believe it was the consensus of the committee members present at the presentation that our job was done. We had studied and recommended a location proximal to Town Center as the location with the shortest response times to most parts of Town. We look forward to the appointment of a building Committee so that this most important project for the Town can continue at a pace appropriate to the Town's needs.

I invite other members of the Committee to chime in if they have something to add.
