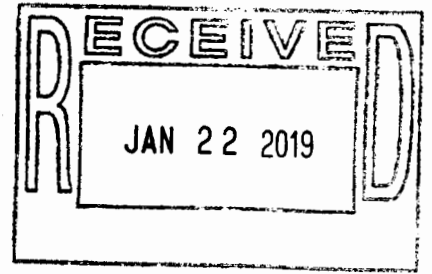

To the Board of Selectman/James Malkin:


