Dear Chair Malkin:

On May 6, 2019, the Martha's Vineyard Regional High School District School Committee voted to use two hundred twenty-nine thousand seven hundred thirty dollars (\$229,730) of Excess & Deficiency funds to fund anticipated deficits in the FY19 budget. Deficits are anticipated in the cost areas of heating oil, building maintenance, and transportation.

As referenced in 603 CMR 41.05, the Martha's Vineyard Regional High School District School Committee is sending this letter to notify the member towns of the amendment to the FY19 previously approved budget.

The local appropriating authority of every member town shall have forty-five (45) days from the date of the Martha's Vineyard Regional High School District School Committee vote to meet and consider the amendment. The proposed amendment shall be effective if it is approved by two-thirds of the local appropriating authorities. If a member town does not vote on the proposed amendment within the forty-five (45) day period, that member town shall be deemed to have approved the amended budget.
