Chairman Tarlov called this Special Meeting of the Board of Finance to order at 7:01 p.m.

### 2. CITIZENS COMMENTS

Joyce Main voiced her concern regarding the amount of teachers that have actually been eliminated over the course of six years. She said in her calculations she is not coming up with the same numbers that the Board of Education has stated and she also questioned the size of the support staff.

## 3. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION FY2012-2013 BUDGET

Ron Goldstein presented the Board members with the Board of Education proposed budget cuts totaling \$350,000. Discussion followed on the items presented.

Karen Loiselle commented regarding the teacher reduction concern. She stated that as of next year they will have reduced their teachers by 24.7 which is one teacher per 14 students. She will put together a chart that will support this figure. M. Cosgrove stated that the data Joyce Main was referring to includes all certified staff not only the teachers.

The Board of Finance will hold a meeting tomorrow night to finalize the proposed budget figures.

#### 4. CITIZEN COMMENTS

Tarice Peters had a question regarding how it is determined which teachers are cut. Karen Loiselle addressed this question.
