Chief Cox called the meeting to order @ 1900 hours.

Budget Issues: Next yr fiscal budget: special BOS meeting currently taking place to revisit next yr's numbers. The town will be going to bond for fire truck & ambulance, high school track, portables. Items to be numbered.

This yr's budget: attempt to hold line, freeze expenditures except request for EMS gear (\$1500), and training (\$10,000) apprx. Figures.

Career Staff/Personnel: Introduced new Administrative Assistant – Jean Walsh K. McManus working short term per diem to cover for D. Lee Sue Dubb, back in service, SOP re: radios – Matt O'Connor will only get radio when on duty.(no radio car to be assigned) As well as Keith Erickson.

Training: Chief McKenna given email re: Lisbon FD will be having training. (water supply tanker shuttle)

Discussed on Salem, CT: House of Doors: burn house being requested.

April training calendar posted. We have to revert to last yrs. #'s. Category 3 requires training: (13) 6 people off list, leaves 7 on list. 3 additional members removed from list due to review of list and update as to having performed training. Have till 4/15 to obtain their training.

2 members to change status: Heidi Palms – no longer wants to hold MRT cert, will stay in Fire Police div.

Lt Sandy Brown – will stay in fire div, change to exterior firefighter.

\$5000 re-certs & training will be scheduled.

Many people doing online testing: no required passing grade. 2AC is recommending 70% minimum standard, for all past and future tests. If 70 is not obtained – re-tests to be reviewed as possibility, or course will have to be taken again. Pool of questions will be reviewed as well. Recommendation: a larger pool of questions should be included.

Thurs. 4/9 will be proposing bylaw change: section 1(b) – to be removed, 3(a) – recommending word training to be removed. Points no longer used, replaced by matrix. Should be less confusing for audit committee.

J. Knapp – question on what training is needed. Every one is required to have exact training. Is matrix going away. No. Will lump any non-specific training will be lumped inot other. Capt responsible for staff to meet training requirements. Wants to discuss this further. Warning: point

system is the only way a member can be removed. To remove points is dangerous. However – more important is to keep people on roster to keep people attending calls.

Chief: confined need for space, hazmat, and trench rescue questioned status. Training to be set up for fall.
