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1. Call to Order

Chairman O'Leary stated that the permits need to be in place for the leagues and another field needs to be located for Flag Football due to the poor condition of R8 field.

Hancin stated the Sports Council meeting to schedule winter sports will be held on September 23, 2013 at 6:00pm. P. McDowell stated her concern regarding endorsed leagues having gym time in the schools outside of their season. Chairman O'Leary stated an invitation needs to be extended to the Board of Education to clarify what their policy is.
