A. Land Development Regulations

Chairman Mathieu told the public that the Commission would again take comments from members of varies Boards and Commissions and audience as they did at the last meeting. He stated that this was not a Public Hearing and explained the procedure to present comments regarding the proposed Regulations. He stated that Staff is still gathering comments from all Land Use related Commissions and all comments will be given to Planning and Zoning Commission members when these comments are compiled.

A. Turner told the Commission that he has met and presented the draft Code to the Open Space, Conservation Commission, Zoning Board of Appeals and the Agricultural Commission and is going to meet with the Economic Development Commission next week and will attend the Agricultural Commission meeting in February. He will also be meeting with the Zoning Board of Appeals again after Town Counsel reviews the draft regulations that are pertinent to the applications that will be heard by this Board.

Stephen Fedus, East Shore Drive, Colchester said he is in favor of the adoption of the new Land Development Regulations because of the increase in the density requirements for multi-family developments.

Joan Nichols, New London County - CT Farm Bureau Association, suggested that the Agricultural Commission form a Sub-committee and compile draft Agricultural regulations to be submitted to the Planning and Zoning Commission.

Chairman Mathieu suggested that the Agricultural Commission present broader concept proposals to the Planning and Zoning Commission who would review these and incorporate those agreed upon into the draft Land Development Regulations. He stated that this would need to be done in a timely manner.

David Wasniewski, Vice Chairman of the Agricultural Commission, made comments regarding the process and the Plan of Conservation and Development.

A. Turner, Town Planner, stated that Staff is in the process of gathering information and maps to update the Plan of Conservation and Development. Discussion followed.

Leslie Curtis, Secretary of the Agricultural Commission, suggested a joint meeting between the Planning and Zoning Commission and the Agricultural Commission.

Andy George, Heatherwood Drive, said he felt the Plan of Conservation and Development should be addressed before the revision of the Land Development Regulations.

B. Commission Discussion on Plan of Conservation and Development

A. Turner gave a brief overview the principles of the Plan of Conservation and Development and how the current plan is responding. He told the Commission that several important studies and plans were completed over the last five (5) years including Agricultural Issue Assessment, Open Space Plan, and Housing Study. He said that Staff is working on updating maps and statistical information at the present time. He said that the State has amended the Statute relieving municipal planning commissions from the obligation of having to prepare or amend a municipal plan between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2013, and suspends the disqualification provision regarding discretionary state funding until July 1, 2014.

Chairman Mathieu said that a discussion was held in 2011 by the Commission regarding updating the Plan of Conservation of Development or revising the regulations and the Commission felt that revision of the Zoning regulations was an item that needed to be address according to the Plan of Conservation and Development. Discussion followed.

Chairman Mathieu stated that it is the consensus of the Commission to complete the process of revising the Land Development Regulations at this time rather than beginning updating the Plan of Conservation and Development.
