 - A. <u>SD#16-041 Modification to SUB#15-433 "Park Place" Subdivision.</u> Park Place Holdings, LLC. Old Hebron Road, Assessor's Map 06-08 Lot 001-001. Property is located in the Suburban Zone. Site Plan modification to eliminate sidewalks on Old Hartford Road.

Chairman Mathieu said that this application had not been acted on at the September 7th Commission meeting because the Colchester Conservation Commission had not acted on it at that time.

D. Schaub reviewed the application for the modification to the approved subdivision with the Commission. She said that the modification was to eliminate the sidewalks on the Old Hartford Road portion of the property. She read the approval letter of the Colchester Conservation Commission to the Commission. Discussion followed regarding the location of the proposed sidewalks on Old Hartford Road.

Motion by M. Noniewicz, seconded by J. Tinelle to approve the modification of Subdivision application, SD#16-041 for SUB #16-433 to not require a sidewalk to be constructed along the Old Hartford Road portion of the property for the following reasons:

- 3. The location of the proposed sidewalk is not near any public schools, high residential or commercial Development that, by not constructing the sidewalk, would be a threat to public safety.
- 4. The applicant will convey a 15 foot wide easement to the State of Connecticut to provide an area for the construction of sidewalks should it be determined that additional sidewalks on Old Hartford Road would be be beneficial to the Town of Colchester in the future.
