RE: Monthly Report for December 2013 (January, 2014 meeting)

Monthly activity: statistics - previously submitted I.

- S.R.O. activity -- Ofc. Edwards has been active in schools as SRO, several arrests/referrals made.
- b. All CPD personnel on full duty, no long term absences to report.
- Beginning budget proposal for FY 2014-2015.

Equipment: Π.

- Vehicles-
 - Cars have been inspected and are up to date in preventive maintenance; all 8 vehicles in service.
 - New police vehicle on order from Columbia Ford, electronics (radio, MDT, etc.) are in, along with trunk vault.
- In car video/MDT-

Wireless upload is still being repaired. Additional equipment (wireless router) needs to be installed in office to make upload operable; router has been obtained. A subsequent meeting is being scheduled.

Radio Replacement-

Based upon information from CSP, within two years all town portable radios (12) as well as six (6) mobile radios will need to be replaced. CSP is updating entire radio system and in approx 11/2 -2 years the obsolete radios we currently have will not function. This will be included in the next 2 upcoming budget proposals to replace the radios; this will be a significant cost to PD.

III. Officer Training:

- a. All officers are current in their POST certifications and training.
- b. Ofc. Labonte and Sgt. Suchecki recently attended Identity Theft Investigation Training.

IV. Initiatives:

- a. RX Drug drop box. 389 lbs. of prescription drugs have been dropped off as of 12/24/13.
- Officers are continuing visibility/enforcement patrols at Youth Center at open hours.
- TRIAD program has been re-started with Senior Center. Regular monthly meeting are underway.

Notable Investigations: V.

- Identity Theft at Ichiban is still active, news release sent out to update investigation.
- Ofc. Edwards has made several drug-related arrests in his capacity as SRO.
