- **Monthly activity: statistics -- previously submitted**
 - All CPD officers on full duty.
 - Budget for FY 2014-2015 passed.
- **Equipment:**
 - Vehicles - All vehicles in service.
 - New police vehicle delivered and in service
 - Radio Replacement- Ordered 3 mobile and 6 portable radios from NE Communications.
- **Officer Training:**
 - All officers are current in their POST certifications and training.
 - Attempting to schedule Taser Instructor training for CPD instructors
 - CSP is providing free ½ day in-service training for all Officers in RT program in August 2014.
- **Initiatives:**
 - RX Drug drop box. -- over 500 lbs. of prescription drugs have been dropped off as of 5/31/14.
- **Notable Investigations:**
 - Officers have been making an increased amount of heroin arrests either on-site or in connection with other offenses. CPD is making drug violations a priority.
 - Arson at old Jack's Chevrolet was solved with juvenile arrests made.
