Minutes of the 14 November 2007 Regular Monthly Meeting Municipal Office Complex Colchester, Connecticut

1. Call to Order – Chairman Tarlov called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

2. 4. Subcommittee Reports

A. Finance Subcommittee – M. Decker reported budget documentation is not available as new Financial Assistant arrived 5 November and is just pulling information together after that position was vacant for a considerable period of time.

(A. Pelletier entered the meeting)

Motion approved 5-0 (A. Pelletier abstained). Copies of the Transfer requests are attached and made part of these minutes.

M. Decker reported there had been no word from the Treasury Department on the status of the DWSRF loan agreement so he contacted the DPH to keep the pressure on. They have helped the process move again and the agreement is expected to arrive within the week.

6. Sewer Activities

- **A. Joint Facilities Report –** K. Fargnoli reported discussion topics included status of the Lyman and Rapallo viaduct projects, GreenStream energy generation system agreement was tabled due to language issues, and the Enhanced Protein Recovery System project is still moving forward.
- **B.** Sewer Activities Report mowed all sewer easements, an odor issue behind Cibo's on South Main was investigated and found no blockage in the mains; sewer blockage behind the Post Office was determined to be within their portion of the line
