- 5. Bake Sale Committee
 - a. We would like to create a group of individuals that would be responsible for holding bake sales in order to spread the word about Youth FIRST and to raise funds. They will be at open houses, events at the schools, etc. It could be people other than those on our board as a way of being involved with a lesser commitment level in terms of time. We can speak to people we know and place an ad in the digital backpack looking for interested family members.
