

- 1. Rob Suchecki called meeting to order at 5:00 pm
- 2. Kathy Wonderly motion to approve March meeting minutes, Lorraine Marvin seconds the motion.
- 3. No public comments.
- 4. New Business
 - a. No program update questions
 - b. Drug Free Community Mentoring Grant
 - 1. Working with Christine from SERAC for the opportunity
 - 2. Youth First/ Advisory Board would also serve as the Drug Prevention Coalition. We will need to add representatives from a couple required sectors to make it complete.
 - 3. The goal of the DFC grant is to change environmental factors, making substance abuse unacceptable and unavailable. We want to change the culture

- 5. Old Business
 - a. Summer Kick Off/ Palooza
 - 1. Not enough information or time available to sponsor a 5k, maybe something to research and plan for the Fall.

- 2. Summer Kick off would take place on the last day of school, June 19, which is statistically a higher usage and experimental day for drugs and alcohol among youth.
- 3. \$10 wristbands to be sold in advance
- 4. DJ, Photobooth, Inflatables, Dunk tank
- 5. Open to students in 5-8 grade??
- 6. Include the climbing center
- 7. Need to get shirts for volunteers.
- 8. In order for the event to be able to take place, we would need at least 30 adult volunteers from 11am-3:30pm. We will reach out to the PTO, Middle school parents groups, etc. Board members are asked to give us a list of volunteers by April 10th.
