

## 2/19/2015 Dartmouth Agricultural Commission Minutes

Members present: Jim Munger, Susan Murray, Sandy Gosselin, Bev King, Vince Frary, David Brownell, Sue Guiducci, and Fred Dabney

The meeting was called to order at 6:40

Secretary's report: the previous meeting's minutes were approved 8-0-0

Treasurer's report: no change in this period.

Philip Lantz was appointed delegate from the Financial Com., to the Agricultural Preservation Trust Com. 8-0-0.

Copicut Farms waits for a new RFP from Greg Barnes, who as issues with affordability. The Commision and the Vincents continue to work for a straight single-season lease.

Matte: The Commission will withdraw its advocacy of assuming the Town's right of first refusal as there semms to be no farmer or other entity willing to purchase or preserve the property.

ALPC/MDAR: Fred noted that despite cordial relations with the new Commissioner, most of the current staff at APR and MDAR seem well entrenched.

Animal/piggery regs: Vince noted several issues still to be resolved: 1)separation of piggery and other animal regs, 2)deletion of any regs governing feed, 3)elimination of abutter notification, 4) definition of "confinement" (are pigs in a barn during winter weather "confined?),5)does "facility" constitute the entire farm, 6)vagueness in use of the term "livestock."

Schofield farm—Issues regarding conditions at the farm were raised as the farm applies for a piggery liscense.

Farm Bureau: The annual Legislative Breakfast is upcoming.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:50.
