Meeting convened at 6:13p.m.

- 1.) Minutes unanimously approved 4-0.
- 2.) Allison Bellora has information related to the introduction to assistive technology. Melissa Cordeiro is familiar with this material as she uses some of it at her job.
- 3.) Manny Cordeiro confirmed that the work at Southworth Library will begin in the Spring. Work at Demello School was approved by the planning board and will also begin in the Spring.
- 4.) Commission discussed allotting \$10,500 for improvements at Cushman School should the Kindergarten program proceed.
- 5.) The CIP meets next week. Commission discussed the following:
 - a.) Allotting \$50,000 for school projects, such as Memorial Stadium. Possible improvements would be a handicapped seating area, the concrete pads to put the seating on, a walkway from ticket booth to seating and restrooms/concessions and back.
 - b.) Allotting \$50,000 for various town projects to include: \$10,000 for the town hall and \$15,000 for handicap accessible electric door, overhang above door and curb cut at the Verizon phone in front of town hall.
- 6.) Further discussion of beach wheelchairs that need to be purchased by the end of the year in order to receive the discount. Commission and the Park and Rec. Dept. decided on two chairs per beach for a total of six chairs.
- 7.) Discussed allotting more money to Manny Cordeiro for school projects but did not make it official.
- 8.) Next meeting January 13th at 6:30 p.m.
