Comparative Data Analysis

- Motion: Fran moves to transfer \$7500 for funding of comparative analysis report (George seconds)
- Discussion
- Fran: people there impressed, neutral group, people suspect of in house comparison
- Pete: references?
- Mike: Ed spoke with Bernie Lynch (CAO of Lowell), thought information was very helpful, useful for providing info, components used on regular basis, data on police/fire compensation and benefits useful, same true for DTA
- Greg: one town did use for negotiations, two administrators did not think data was useful
- Ed: 1/3 of communities respond to MMPA
- Greg: comparative data between communities not good
- Mike: useful data revenue by source, over time; comparison of debt (load, service); education (per capita v. per pupil, impact of enrollment on spending, sped comparison, technology and infrastructure spending, teaching and institutional staffing, salary break down and pay grid analysis) compensation and benefits for policy and general government employees; waste and water spending; roads spending
- Shannon: questions about quality of data in analysis
- Stu: defer to SB
- George: other people too busy to do this, give it a try; wary of using for collective bargaining purposes
- Dave: geographic comparisons should look at SouthCoast communities
- Greg: how can this help us save money?

- Mike: infrastructure analysis; road spending
- Pete: small amount, requested by SB and town administration
- George: move question (Shannon second): unanimous (7-0)
- Vote: 7-0 unanimous

Revenue Based verses Needs Based Budget Process

- Greg:
  - Westport deals with difference from year to year
  - o fund mandates, obligations, reserves, stab fund
  - o leftovers go to departments
  - o we ask what departments need and that is whittled down
  - o instead impose 2% cuts
- Ed:
  - o SB identifies public safety as high priority

Quarterly Update on Revenue and Expenses including Legal Expenses

- Legal
  - Mike: fairly close to being on target, pay Prentiss for eminent domain case (8K); matters outside town counsel: two arbitration cases; expended ~75K, have ~205 in account; have potential exposures above what is appropriated
  - Melissa: charge back water eminent domain/Prentiss to water fund?
  - Mike: in discussion with DPW on this
  - George: investigate other arbitration companies for better price
- Revenues and Expenses
  - Ed: sent July, August and September revenues no cause for concern here; expenditures from July – September – no cause for concern here either; biggest concern = motor vehicle
  - Fran: 2% cut how are departments doing?

• Ed: being monitored, most big departments in compliance, some small departments are not
