ARTICLE 1: To choose a Moderator for the ensuing year.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the District will vote to compensate firefighter recruits at the rate of \$18.00 per hour, firefighter Step 1 at the rate of \$23.00 per hour, firefighter Step 2 at the rate of \$21.00 per hour, lieutenants at the rate of \$25.00 per hour, house captains at the rate of \$22.00 per hour and line captains at the rate of \$27.00 per hour and dispatchers at the rate of \$19.00 per hour for toned incidents and to further compensate all district personnel for all other duties at the rate of \$19.00 per hour.
