Director's Report

>GAF Engineering will be surveying Evergreen Cemetery. Mr. Lancaster will meet with the engineer on Thursday at the site.

>Both dump trucks are in need of repair. The remaining funds in the department budget will not last through the end of the fiscal year. A reserve fund transfer will be requested from the Finance Committee

>Christian's Law states that life vests must be worn by every child during swim time or beach days at the summer programs that do not pass the swim test. The municipalities are responsible for evaluating each child's swimming ability and determining whether or not the child must wear the life vest. The Director does not want the liability on the town should something happen to the child that passed the test. Further discussion will ensue if and when the law passes.

Motion made and seconded to promote John Baglini to Assistant Beach Supervisor. Voted 4-0-0


Dartmouth Turns 350

The next Parks & Recreation Board meeting will be held on May 20, 2013 at 6:30 P.M.


