Final Minutes

The Greater New Bedford Regional Refuse Management District Committee held a publicly posted meeting on Thursday, March 13, 2014 at 3:45 PM at the Dartmouth Town Hall, Room 305, 400 Slocum Road, Dartmouth, MA.

Also present: Scott Alfonse, Executive Director; and Cynthia Cammarata, Secretary. Also in attendance was Cynthia Marland, DCTV Director of Media.

## 1. Call to Order

Chairperson Tierney called the meeting to order at 3:45 PM.

# 2. Salute to the Flag

All in attendance stood to salute the Flag.

# 3. Legal Notices

Chairperson Tierney asked for a motion to accept that the Legal Notices were posted timely both in New Bedford and Dartmouth. Motion made by Mrs. Dias, seconded by Mr. Mitchel. Voted 5-0.

Chairperson Tierney said she would entertain a motion to hear the Public Comment out of order. Motion made by Mrs. Dias, seconded by Mr. Mitchell. Voted 5-0.

Chairperson Tierney recognized Dr. Cynthia Marland, Director of Media for Dartmouth Community Access Television. Dr. Marland passed out a calendar of events for Dartmouth's 350<sup>th</sup> birthday. She explained that this will be a celebration spanning over a five month time period. The parade will be at least a one and one half hour event. Mr. Alfonse mentioned that the Boy Scouts will be using one of the Districts trailers.

Dr. Marland told the Board the Dartmouth 350 Committee will be placing about 14 kiosks around town; which will provide some history of each area. Dr. Marland asked if the District could provide some sponsorship to the Dartmouth 350, which has a non-profit status. Mr. Alfonse and Mrs. Cammarata did not know if a monetary contribution is something that the District can legally do. Ms. Marland said that each kiosk is \$2,500, and the name of the organization sponsoring them will go on each plate. Mr. Alfonse will check to see if that is something that the District can legally do.

Mr. King arrived.

The Students would be insured under the University's policy. Mr. Alfonse plans to put this out to bid in the future; the University would be able to bid on these services as well.
