6:30/Meeting with David Vincent.

6:55/Meeting with Cyndi Marland-Relocation of DCTV Studio.

Cyndi Marland, Director of Media, briefed the Board on the relocation of DCTV Studio stating she received a letter from Dr. Stephen Russell, Superintendent of Dartmouth Public Schools. He informed Ms. Marland that the School Committee needs this area for the upcoming September 2009 school year for a classroom. Ms. Marland informed the Board that the estimated costs for the move would be \$75,000 to \$100,000. Dr. Marland mentioned the space suggested at 366 Slocum Road is not adequate for a TV studio and asked for the Board's suggestion on the relocation of DCTV.

7:05/Meeting with Chief Mark Pacheco re: Hiring COPS Recovery and award of new Regional Homeland Security Grant.

Chief Mark Pacheco briefed the Board on Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS Office) announced the availability of funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 to address the personnel needs of state, local and tribal law enforcement. CHRP grants will provide 100 percent funding for approved entry-level salaries and benefits for 3 years for newly-hired, full time sworn officer positions or for rehired officers.

The Chief informed the Board at the conclusion of federal funding, grantees must retain all sworn officer positions awarded under the CHRP grant. The retained CHRP-funded position (s) should be added to the grantee's law enforcement budget with state and/or local funds, over and above the number of locally-funded positions that would have existed in the absence of the grant.

Chief Mark Pacheco announced to the Board the award of new Regional Homeland Security Grant in the amount of \$55,033.80. The Chief stated will be used to start the process of introducing a new infrastructure to our collective police radio systems to a new UHF frequency radio system.
