The Chair opened the public meeting at 5:45 p.m.

The Chair polled the Board for a roll call vote to convene into Executive Session pursuant to M.G.L. Ch. 30A, Sec 21: Chair Stone, yes; Vice-Chair McDonald, yes; Selectman Trimble, yes; Selectman Watson, yes; Selectman Michaud, absent.

The Chair called the public meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. on December 17, 2012 in room 304.

I. **Appointments:**

6:45 p.m. Dexter Mead, DNRT, Conservation Restrictions for Teal Pond Trust and Peter's Creek.

- Two conservation restrictions Teal Pond Trust and Peter's Creek.
- Both ponds have strong fresh water flows.
- The conservation restrictions will protect both of these bodies of water.
- A nature trail will be built to educate groups who want to walk the trail at Teal Pond.
- Peter's Creek will allow residents to walk on to islands in the Slocum River by a built causeway.
- These projects are being done by a State Tax Credit.

After a motion was made by Selectman William Trimble and seconded by Selectman Michael Watson, it was voted unanimously (4-0) to approve the conservation restriction for Teal Pond Trust.

After a motion was made by Vice-Chair Shawn McDonald and seconded by Selectman Michael Watson, it was unanimously voted (4-0) to approve the conservation restriction for Peter's Creek.

- Sandy Conaty from SRPEDD spoke in regards to Priority Development and Protection Areas in Dartmouth.

- GIS will be used to provide data to residents at public data workshops.
- There are many Boards and Committees that could have input on this project.

After a motion was made by Selectman Michael Watson and seconded by Selectman William Trimble, it was unanimously approved (4-0) to put the Select Board meeting in recess.

The Chair opened the Affordable Housing Trust Fund Trustees Meeting.

• The Select Board is the trustee for the Affordable Housing Trust Fund and must designate officers.

After a motion was made by Selectman Michael Watson and seconded by Selectman William Trimble, it was unanimously voted (2-0) that Lara

Stone will be designated as the Chair of the Affordable Housing Trust; Vice-Chair Shawn McDonald will be designated as Vice-Chair.

After a motion was made by Selectman Michael Watson and seconded by Selectman William Trimble it was unanimously approved (4-0) to put the Affordable Housing Trust Fund Trustees Meeting in recess.

The Chair re-opened the Select Board Meeting.

 Application for the New Bedford Yacht Club for a Change in Officers/Directors.

After a motion was made by Selectman William Trimble and seconded by Vice-Chair Shawn McDonald, it was voted unanimously (4-0) to approve the Directors /Officers change for the New Bedford Yacht Club.

New Business:

- A. Green Community Vehicle Policy.
 - A new vehicle policy will be put in place to become a designated green community.

After a motion was made by Selectman William Trimble and seconded by Vice-Chair Shawn McDonald, it was unanimously voted (4-0) to approve the Green Community Vehicle Policy.

- B. Community Septic Management Interim Loan Note.
 - Interim loan in accordance with what Town Meeting authorized for adoption this past June.

After a motion was made by Vice-Chair Shawn McDonald and seconded by Selectman Michael Watson, it was unanimously voted (4-0) to approve the borrowing of \$400,000.00 pursuant to Chapter 49C and Chapter 11 of General Laws and the passing of Article 16 at the June 2012 Town Meeting for the Community Septic Management Program and to incorporate the whole document.

- C. Request from Buster's Restaurant and Hawthorne Country Club (Wedding) for the extension of their license to serve Alcohol on December 31, 2012-January 1st to 2 a.m. instead of 1 a.m.
 - Alcohol license extensions for New Year's Eve from 1a.m. to 2a.m.
 - The Select Board would like to place a restriction requiring both businesses to serve food until 2a.m.
 - The Police Department needs to be aware of the extended time change.

• The Select Board would like a notice sent to both owners to be extra cautious due to the extension of alcohol consumption.

After a motion was made by Selectman Michael Watson and seconded by Vice-Chair Shawn McDonald, it was voted (3-0, 1 abstention-Trimble) to approve the extension of the Alcohol licenses of Buster's Sport's Bar and Hawthorne Country Club with a restriction that food must be served until 2.am.

- D. Stat Ambulance Run Times.
 - Running at an 8 min. response time currently.
- E. Renewal Application of Patrick Duddy for a Constable License.

 After a motion was made by Selectman William Trimble and seconded by Selectman Michael Watson, it was unanimously voted (4-0) to approve the Constable License for Patrick Duddy.
- F. Reappointment of Daniel Cook to the Youth Commission.

- I. Three Tier Real Estate Tax Classification, Mike Fernandes' Proposal.
 - Selectman Michael Watson and Town Administrator David Cressman will meet with State Rep. Christopher Markey to discuss this proposal amongst other things related to a Three Tier Real Estate Classification System.
- J. Proposed Letters Petitioning State Legislation Articles adopted at the October 2012 Town Meeting.

After a motion was made by Vice-Chair Shawn McDonald and seconded by Selectman Michael Watson, it was unanimously voted (4-0) to

approve the Town Administrator to send a letter petitioning for the State Legislation Articles from the October 2012 Town Meeting to be adopted.

- K. Labor Counsel.
 - The Select Board will extend the Labor Counsel contract until the Police Brotherhood negotiations are completed. Once they are complete an RFP will be sent out for Labor Counsel.

After a motion was made by Selectman Michael Watson and seconded by Selectman William Trimble, it was unanimously voted (4-0) to approve the extension of the Labor Counsel contract.

- L. Report on Goals & Objectives.
 - The Town Administrator feels as though he has achieved the majority of the goals and objectives that have been set for him.
 - New Town Accountant has been added along with a Personnel Administrator vacancy.
 - Automated Bill Pay was rolled out earlier this year.
 - Maintained our Fiscal accountability.
 - A strategic process has been executed (resident survey).
 - A new Vehicle Policy has been adopted.
 - More communication with UMass Dartmouth.

After a motion was made by Selectman William Trimble and seconded by Selectman Michael Watson it was unanimously approved (4-0) to put the Select Board Meeting in recess.

The Chair opened the Affordable Housing Trust Fund Trustees Meeting.

After a motion was made by Selectman Michael Watson and seconded by Vice-Chair Shawn McDonald it was unanimously approved (4-0) to re-open the Select Board Meeting.

- Mr. Delgado (Midway Realty LLC) has sent a letter making a commitment of \$50k to be used toward affordable housing units at Lincoln Park Commons. (36 unit mixed income building).
- An agreement was drafted by Town Counsel on how the \$50k commitment will be used by the Trustees.
- A letter will be signed by the Select Board agreeing to the \$50k contribution.

After a motion was made by Selectman William Trimble and seconded by Vice-Chair Shawn McDonald, it was unanimously voted (4-0) to approve accepting the \$50K commitment from Midway Realty LLC to be used toward affordable housing units by Lincoln Park Commons LLC.

The Chair closed the Affordable Housing Trust Fund Trustees Meeting.
