Member Raymond addressed the Commission concerning new plans for an addition to Headquarters. There were some questions asked such as where this stood with the Selectmen, Board of Finance, and public interest.

A gift certificate will go out to G. Clark Jr., for all his volunteer hours and equipment he used last year for grounds maintenance. Spitzschuh will follow through with this.

Fire Marshal submitted bills, Activity Report.

The Engineer reports he will be on vacation soon.

They have had no luck selling the emergency truck. Budney asked if it could go to auction.

1 has gone on the internet to find a price for it. Looks like asking price will turn out to be \$7,500.00.

Universal steering in the car is shot and will cost a couple hundred to fix.

Other business was a letter from the Town Clerk for 2010 annual agenda. This was not discussed last month, but has already been filed.


