The January 4, 2010 meeting of the Deep River Fire Commission began at 7:01 PM with Spitzschuh, Budney, Bearardis, and Kollmer in attendance. Fire Marshal Nolin was also present. Woodcock was excused.

The December 7, 2009 minutes were reviewed. Accepted with the correction that Jerry Clark was to receive a gift card. Moved Kollmer, 2nd, Berardis. Unan.

Financial statements were reviewed. Budney questioned a bill for either oil or propane and will discuss this entry with Town Hall, as well as several entries for ACME. They appear to be from another organization.

Plowing for December was \$120.00 for both stations.

Deputy reported for the Chief and himself. There were 19 calls last month. This includes shoveling the roof at DRES. They also found some problems within the building and have reported them to the Building Inspector.

59 has been sold and the money turned over to the Town to be put in the general fund. The car has been fixed.

There is an issue with the heat at Headquarters. Budney has ordered the parts and will make the adjustments when the parts are in. This should cost \$500.00 to 1,000.00.

Fire Marshal submitted bills, Activity Report. He also handed out yearly pie charts for all calls for last year.

Deputy reported for the Engineer. 59 is sold, the car is fixed.

Chairman questioned any feed back on the meeting with the Selectmen and Board of Finance. Commissioners believe that meeting went well. There is no definite answer. The plans have been handed to the Town's Building design committee for review and recommendations. A letter to the public about this project will go out closer to the public hearing.

There was no other business.

Other business consisted on putting off Fire Commission election of officers until next month, after the Fire Department holds their elections to see if there will be any changes to the Commission.
