Some equipment will be removed before the transaction occurs. Member Raymond and the Chief went to a Design Committee meeting and heard the suggestions they would make for the addition to the Fir Station. They would like to see the parking lot partially paved and the house to stay.

Three Juniors took the EMR course.

The structure fir on River Lane was the largest call last month.

Thy Deputy said there were three injuries last month.

Fire Marshal submitted bills, Activity Report.

Dunkin Doughnuts said a dialer on the alarm system will be hooked up. Submitted plans for an upcoming Tent Event, to ensure proper coverage from the Department.

There was no Engineer's report.

There was no Chairman's report.

There was no Old Business.

Under Other Business the budget was discussed. The need to upgrade radios was of foremost importance. The Commission agreed to allow the purchase of these radios, as long as it did not go over the current budget.

Another item discussed was a more powerful cutter which would allow access for firefighters as a "jaws of life" tool for newer vehicles where materials on newer vehicles are resistant to the old tools used.

The exhaust system on the pick up was rotted and repaired for \$300.00.
