The September 12, 2011 meeting of the Deep River Fire Commission began at 6:59 P.M. with Lee, and Woodcock, Kollmer and Spitzschuh in attendance. Fire Marshal Nolin was also present.

Berardis was excused.

The August 1, 2011 minutes were reviewed. The minutes carried as written. Moved by Woodcock, 2<sup>nd</sup>, Kollmer. Unan.

Financial Statement was reviewed. All bills were normal.

Chief reported 32 calls last month. There were 56 calls generated due to the storm. There should be no change with vehicle fuel or maintenance due to the active month. Some of the barricades and cones have not been located after the storm. Some money may be needed to replace these items. FEMA money might be able to be used for replacement.

The training schedule has been messed up, but is getting back to normal.

Fireworks and the barbeque are this Saturday.

Sunday is the Fire Convention. He will pursue the problem with impassable roads with the Selectman.

Deputy asked about the status of Piano Works. There is a new company from Old Lyme in charge of the alarm system. Fire Marshal spoke with the company and requested a name from the firm be listed as a key holder for emergencies.

Deputy also inquired about the Fire Marshal's radio capacity. All seemed well for this time.

Fire Marshal submitted bills, Activity Report.

He spoke about the fireworks and asked to have emergency vehicles at the site by 6:00 P.M. He also requested to make sure there was good access on the road.


