Four Junior's want to go to Cadet Class. Money for these classes will come from the Training Budget.

A letter will go out to Don Lee, after one of his family members was in a serious accident.

There was no Engineer's report.

Fire Marshal submitted Activity Report, bills.

He said the resident at 173 Essex Street has replaced all detectors and has inquired about leaving a key outside the home.

He has been called into the Town Hall to take care of some issues upstairs, so it can be used more often


