The March 5, 2012 meeting of the Deep River Fire Commission began at 7:00 P.M. with Budney, Berardis, Lee, and Spitzschuh attendance. Fire Marshal Nolin was also present.

The February 6, 2012 minutes were reviewed. The minutes carried as written. Unan.

There were no Financial Statements.

There are some lines which are close now and will be exhausted by the end of this budget. Year end maintenance on the trucks are also due before the new budget year. Other bills were normal.

The Chief reports the Fire Department call log matched the fire Marshal's last month. There were a few brush fires last month, and he received a call after one of them, which showed the Brush Truck had rot holes in the bottom. It was brought to First Line, and it was recommended that it should not be repaired due to age, but the parts replaced instead. The Chief went to the Selectmen and was asked to go to the Joint Meeting with the Selectmen and Board of Finance. At that meeting, it was voted that he could spend up to \$12,000.00 to fix the truck. An invitation to bid on the work was placed in the paper. It was also decided that the Department would retain the pump, but get rid of the tank. The Rescue truck is back in service. He will see if the Commission can be contacted by the Selectmen prior to the budget workshop for the department. This way someone could be on hand to answer any questions about the Department's budget that may come up.

There was no Deputy's report.

There was no Engineer's report.

Fire Marshal submitted Activity Report, bills.

He said a new restaurant would be coming to Town soon.

There was also a discussion about the old Champion Manufacturing building. He had an inquiry about how to sub-divide that property.

The Chairman invited all Firemen to a Firemen's mass at the Congregational on March 25<sup>th</sup>. report under other business.

Under Old Business, it was asked if a replacement was found to take Kollmer's vacant seat on the Board.

Meeting adjourned at 7:30. Unan.

- 02/14/2012 Fire Department response to 223 Warsaw Street for an outside smoke investigation. Units discovered a control burn. 5FM investigated and units extinguished the fire & secured.

- 02/15/2012 Fire Department response to Hillside Terrace for an outside smoke investigation. Units discovered a leaf pile burning. Units extinguished the fire, 5FM discovered the homeowner had dumped hot ashes in that area earlier in the day and units secured.

- 02/19/2012 Fire Department response to 92 Main Street, Piano Works Condominiums for a public service. Units discovered a leaking water heater, turned off the water supply and secured.
