The old truck will soon be advertised, however there is already interest in it from an organization in Maine. The Department made 2 trips to Long Island following Storm Sandy. Both trips were very effective.

There is a new Architect for the Building Committee, who has requested information from the old Architect. Chief has handed this to the Selectmen to take care of.

The Deputy said a Forestry Grant was ready to go out.

The Department is in need of a few TV's, a stove, and refrigerators. TV's are needed at both stations to monitor weather conditions during storms. Stove and Fridge should be upgraded/updated, and many end up using less electricity and maintenance. The Commission agreed the TV's and fridge should be replaced at this time, and should start pricing the cost of replacing the stove.
