The minutes of Oct. 2013 were reviewed. They accepted as written. Moved by Lee, 2nd Budney. Unan.

The Financial Statements were reviewed.

The bill for extinguishers, which were gages, has not been corrected yet.

All other bills were normal.

The Chief reported 8 calls.

A Department member has a supply of smoke detectors to put on the trucks. If someone is in need of a smoke detector, they should call Headquarters. This has already been approved by both the Town Hall and their Attorney.

The new truck is in Pennsylvania. The final inspection did not go as well as they wanted, but the company has agreed to be corrected. Delivery will be put off until around the new year.

This presented a small problem with the buyer of the old truck. It seems that problem had been satisfactorily corrected also.

The Deputy reports the language in the SOG's need to be rewritten to avoid problems in the future.

There was no Engineer's report. A problem with the GPS on the boat has been fixed.

- 10/26/2013 Fire Department response to 60 Main Street, Kirtland Commons for an Automatic Alarm of Fire. Units discovered the smoke detector activation was caused by burnt food, 5FM investigated & units secured.
- 10/28/2013 Fire Department response Mutual Aid to Essex, 11 Lookout Hill Road for a C.O. detector activation. Units were canceled enroute & secured.
- 10/30/2013 5FM put new keys in the Knox Box at 60 Main Street, Kirtland Commons.
- 10/30/2013 Fire Department response to 12 River Street, Deep River Elementary School for an odor of smoke in the building. Units discovered the odor was caused by a partial power outage, 5FM investigated & units secured.
