FIRE MARSHAL ACTIVITY REPORT APRIL 2015

- 4/1/15 5FM conducted a pre-blast inspection on Read St for the sewer project. A permit was issued to Shoreline Blasting.
- 4/1/15 5FM conducted an inspection of the auditorium at Town Hall, 174 Main St.
- 4/06/15 Fire Department responded to the area of 145 Warsaw St for an MVA. Units discovered a car vs. deer, units assisted police & secured.
- 4/06/15 Fire Department responded to the area of W Elm St & Route 9 for a two car MVA. Units took one refusal & secured.
- 4/09/15 Fire Department responded to 151 Main St for a furnace malfunction. Units investigated, metered the building & ventilated.
- 4/9/15 5FM conducted an inspection of Liberty Bank at 151 Main St.
- 4/14/15 Fire Department responded to 5 Barn Dr for a lift assist. Units assisted EMS & secured.
- 4/17/15 Fire Department responded to 199 Union St for a possible Propane gas leak. Units secured the tank and metered the building. Zero readings were found. The smell was believed to have been caused by a dead animal.
- 4/18/15 Fire Department responded to 186 Union St for a brush fire. Upon arrival the fire was out. Units overhauled the fire area and secured.
- 4/20/15 Fire Department responded to 56 Main St for a lift assist. Units assisted EMS and secured.

- 4/21/15 Fire Department responded to 72 Hemlock Dr for an outside fire. Upon arrival units found a controlled burn with a valid permit. No action needed, units secured.
