The Chief handed out a sample Job Description, which was reviewed and adjusted to fit Deep River's needs. This will be brought to the Selectman for review, and editing. He will advise the Commission on where he thinks this posting should go. After the resumes are collected, the Commission will review this situation at the September meeting. It was also mentioned, that a Special Meeting may need to be scheduled to finish this process.

Under Old Business, Lanouette asked about the file cabinet for the Fire Marshal. There was also a discussion concerning the lack of man-power during daytime hours. Budney asked the Commission to think of ideas to correct or change the problem.
