The September 12, 2016 meeting of the Deep River Fire Commission began at 7:14 P.M. with Lee, Bowden, and Budney. David entered later. Fire Marshal Kerop was also in attendance.

Chief reported there was trouble with the electronics with the GPS on the fire boat. It has needed to be rebooted several times. It will have maintenance done on it over the winter. He stated that this month has been and will be very active.

The Fire Department will sponsor the Fire House. Fire Police will be directing traffic during the race, pet parade, and fireworks. He will be receiving a set of prints for a new building to present to, first the Officers, than the Department, before bringing it to the Commission next month.

Deputy reports the catch basin and rebuild on the water hole on Acorn has been done. The one across the street was dug out, and the Town took the dirt away.

There was a discussion on the two hard line phone system. At some point, the necessary testing could not be performed because the line was shared with another department. Some suggestions were made.

Parking in front of the Piano Works was also discussed. The Fire Marshal will form a letter to Piano Works manager to inform the residents about the fire lane. He will also discuss this with the Selectman if needed.

Fire Marshal submitted the Activity Report. It was reviewed.

He reported that he has spent a good amount of time with the school system, both the Elementary School as well as the Regional Schools. This was discussed in detail, and the Commission is seeking measures to offset this problem.

Under Engineer's report, 5-5-2 back from PM and brake work. 5-5-3 will go out tomorrow.

Hose testing has been done.

There was no Chairman's report.

Under Old Business, Bowden submitted information on a supplemental insurance policy. It was determined, he will invite a Rep. from this organization to attend a Commission meeting to discuss this in further detail.

He also pursued information on a truck exhaust system, which the Chief will fill out and fax, as requested.

Bowden also looked into information, and handed out a paperwork on a GPS system for the boat.
