The Board of Finance convened its Regular Meeting at the Deep River Town Hall on April 22, 2014. Meeting called to order by John Bauer at 7:33 PM. **Treasurer's report:** T. Lindner presented Town Deposits Report and Investment Updates for review. Noted two WPCF small accounts will be closed before end of fiscal year.

**Correspondence:** final audit reports received for review, no material weaknesses, audit has been submitted to State Office of Policy and Management.

**Monthly Budget Report Review:** monthly report received for review. Request for next meeting a report on any budget concerns, transfers, adjustments that may be required to finish this fiscal year. Smith requested on behalf of the library an adjustment from the Library Program Expenses (Transfers) line of \$3,050 to the Assistants Salary line to continue a children's reading program.

On MOTION made by G. Eckenroth, second by B. Ballsieper, to approve the proposed Fiscal Year Budget 2014-2015 expenditures of \$15,302,887. Motion CARRIED.

Noted the annual town hearing will be May 6 at 7:30 PM at the town hall auditorium, the annual town meeting on May 19 at 7:30 PM at the town hall auditorium, the vote on the budget will go to referendum.
