Regular Meeting -- December 27, 2011

This regular meeting was called to order at 6:40 pm by Dick Smith.

Minutes: Regular Meeting – December 13, 2011

A motion was made by McDonald, 2nd by Smith, to accept the minutes of the meeting of December 13, 2011.

Village Street Bridge:

A motion was made by McDonald, 2nd by Oliveria, to accept the bid of \$1,119,241.50 from the Brunalli Construction Company, of Southbury, CT. The lowest bid was rejected because it lacked pre-qualification by the CT DOT, as required in the bid documents. Smith noted that the Town had received 16 bids.

Additional Appropriation, Village Street Bridge

Smith explained that there is certain preliminary work, such as surveying and working with adjacent property owners to obtain necessary easements and their purchase, etc.. These tasks are performed at relatively low cost by the CT DOT, which is then reimbursed by the Town. Oliveria moved, McDonald 2nd, that the Town reimburse the State in the amount of \$31,320.
