Margot Hilfinger requested an update on the Village Street Bridge. Smith said that the project remains ahead of schedule, with a planned completion date of late November or early December. With the exception of one small change order it is also within budget.

Bob Jenkins noted that the Streetscape streetlights in the area of the Public Library were not turning on as soon as those near Town Hall or the lights further north. Town Hall employee Jonathan Kastner, who was in attendance, explained that the timer at the Library needed to be re-set, and that he would make the adjustment that evening.

The Special Town Meeting convened. After it adjourned the Board of Finance meeting convened in joint session with the Board of Selectmen.
