Town Project Updates

Smith gave the following updates:

- 1) Snack Shack Storage Area Plattwood Park: footings and foundation have been completed, and the Highway Department will soon be installing conduit necessary for electrical service, water and drainage. The storage area will house equipment necessary for the planned Splash Pad and Lifeguards' equipment.

This project is made possible with the assistance of Iestyn Norton as a part of his Eagle Scout project.

- 2) Phase 5 of the Main Street Streetscape (Church Street to Union/Main intersection): work will begin during June.
- 3) Update on the proposed relocation of Dunkin' Donuts to the intersection of Main and Union Streets (Bartlett's Garage). The Design Advisory Board is reviewing plans, and the application will be on the agenda of the Planning & Zoning Commission at its June 20th regular meeting.
- 4) Smith also stated that the Assessor has compiled a list of all Deep River properties that includes assessed value, present taxes paid and taxes that will result from the new budget of Fiscal Year 2013-14, which resulted in an increase of four-tenths of a mill.

Residents interested in knowing the actual effect of the new tax rate on their property should contact the First Selectman or the Tax Collector.
