

### BOARD OF SELECTMEN

#### DEEP RIVER TOWN HALL

Regular Meeting – July 22, 2014

<u>Attendance:</u> Selectmen Dick Smith, David Oliveria. Also: Margo Hilfinger, John Green (*vidiography*); Jonathan Kastner.

This regular meeting was called to order at 6:45 pm by Dick Smith.

Minutes: Regular Meeting of July 8, 2014

Motion by Oliveria, Smith 2<sup>nd</sup>, to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on July 8, 2014.

#### <u>APPROVED 2-0</u>

#### Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy (C-PACE) Agreement:

Smith explained that C-PACE is a state program whose purpose is to foster economic development by "...facilitating loan financing for clean energy improvements to commercial properties by utilizing a state or local assessment mechanism to provide security for repayment of the loans."

The program is administered by the Clean Energy Finance and Investment Authority, which funds the program through issuing bonds, then making loans to qualifying commercial property owners. The "local assessment mechanism" is the Tax Collector, whose role is to bill loan recipients semi-annually. for which it receives \$500 per year to offset administrative costs.

After discussion among Board members, Oliveria moved, Smith 2<sup>nd</sup>, to sign the agreement.

#### APPROVED 2-0

#### Adjustments to FY 2013-14 Budget:

The Board of Selectmen remained in session during the meeting of the Board of Finance so that Smith could address both concerning additional appropriations / transfers to the FY 2013-14 budget.

Smith presented the Boards with two memos, one detailing over-expenditures and revenues in excess of budget, the other listing budget lines that were under-expended. Following discussion among both Boards it was agreed that the larger over-expenditures (*examples below*) would be covered by the additional revenues:

Overall, total expenditures (*including the above*) were \$ 372,893.75; Revenues in excess of budget totaled \$ 565,531.28.

The remainder of additional revenues will serve to increase the Unappropriated Fund Balance. Oliveria moved, Smith 2<sup>nd</sup>, to approve the adjustments.
