Regular Meeting — June 14, 2016

Minutes: Regular Meeting of May 24, 2016.

Tax Credit for Deep River Congregational Church and Deep River Housing Authority via Neighborhood Assistance Act:

Alison Karam, member of the Deep River Congregational Church Board of Trustees, briefed the Board on their grant application for Tax Credit through Neighborhood Assistance Act for building improvements. The application needs the town's endorsement before being submitted to the State.
