

# **BOARD** OF **SELECTMEN** DEEP RIVER TOWN HALL

Regular Meeting November 8, 2016

This regular meeting was called to order at 6:38pm by McDonald.

#### Minutes:

Meeting of October 25, 2016.

Gates moved, Oliveria 2<sup>nd</sup>, to accept the meeting minutes of October 25, 2016.

# Water Pollution Control Authority (WPCA) Security Improvements:

Oliveria moved, Gates  $2^{nd}$ , to add this item to the agenda.

McDonald discussed security improvements planned for the WPCA facility that consisted of a keypad access gate and possible security cameras (approximately \$25,000). The wording of the ordinance that established the self-funded WPCA directs that all purchases over \$10,000 will be submitted to the Board of Selectmen for review. The board agreed to support this facility improvement.

Oliveria moved, Gates 2<sup>nd</sup>, to authorize the First Selectman to provide a written letter of support to the WPCA for installing a key-pad access gate and possible video camera surveillance.

Oliveria provided an update on the Solarize Chester/ Deep River program.

The November 2<sup>nd</sup> SolarizeCT-Deep River kick-off workshop was a success. Many attended and the presentations were informative. Topics included solar panel basics, state and federal grants, and financing options. The deadline to sign up with this program is February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Future planned events so far include:

- December 7<sup>th</sup> Chester Workshop at the Chester Town Hall
