



BOARD OF SELECTMEN

DEEP RIVER TOWN HALL

Regular Meeting May 9, 2017

Attendance: Selectmen Angus McDonald, David Oliveria & Duane Gates. Also present were Jonathan Kastner with Margo Hilfiger and John Greene (videography).

This regular meeting was called to order at 6:37pm by McDonald.

Minutes:

Approve minutes of regular meeting on April 25, 2017.

Gates moved, Oliveria 2nd, to accept the meeting minutes of April 25, 2017.

Discuss sign boards in front of Town Hall:

McDonald with a brief discussion alternate locations for the sign board(s) and on plans to ask town's Design Advisory Board for their thoughts. Mr. Kastner shared that he had been looking on line for vertical kiosks that could hold announcements and take up a small amount of space.

Audience of Citizens – Any other business to come before the board:

In other business, McDonald provided a status on a variety of activities:

- Agreement of the revised payment schedule to Southern Connecticut Gas for the town's share of running the natural gas line through town; \$7,500 this week, \$42,500 in 2018, and \$25,000 over the next eight years. Tax revenue on the installed gas line should be more than the 10-year interest free payment schedule.

- The town has hired storm drain cleaning services – you may see trucks on your street working on the drains.
- Connecticut Water Company – will be installing the last leg of new line on Kirtland Street.
- Road paving this summer – by July 1, a section of River Road and final coat on Lords Lane will be completed. After July, budget permitting, the southern section of River Road will be done.
- The Board reminds citizens to attend the Annual Town Meeting on May 15th, 7:30pm. The 2017/2018 town budget will be voted on by paper ballot.

Oliveria moved, Gates 2nd, to adjourn at 6:47 pm.
