

BOARD OF SELECTMEN DEEP RIVER TOWN HALL

Regular Meeting June 27, 2017

Attendance: Selectmen Angus McDonald & Duane Gates. Also present were Jonathan

Kastner, Margo Hilfiger and John Greene (videography).

This regular meeting was called to order at 6:48pm by McDonald.

Minutes:

Approve minutes of regular meeting on May 23, 2017.

Gates moved, McDonald 2nd, to accept the meeting minutes of May 23, 2017.

Update on Town projects:

McDonald reported on the Kirtland Street water project. He explained that the pipe was over 100 years old and needed replacing, that the project started last year, but scheduling conflict with the sewer project delayed completion and that the pipe has now been replaced. He also said that a small section of Kirtland Street was not included in the sewer project leaving five properties without access to the new sewer, and that the town will be installing the remaining section this summer, then paving will be scheduled.

McDonald reported on the town wide paving projects that are underway or getting ready to start. Lords Lane would be getting a final pavement added to existing base. A section of River Road will be getting paved now with plans to pave the southern end later in the season. He stated that sections of Fountain Hill Cemetery will be paved. Plattwood Park would be paved at a later date this summer.

McDonald talked about the cleaning of the storm drains (catch basins) that we are required to do. He said this season we are concentrating on East of Main Street. As this is a costly project we can only do a limited amount this year.

McDonald also gave an update on Town stickers for the Dump and Town Parks, explaining that the dump and the Parks have separate stickers and that they are available at the Town Clerks office; you must bring in your vehicle registration or proof of residency.

Audience of Citizens – Any other business to come before the board:

Q1 – Margo Hilfiger asked about the Transfer Station and the time line of changing it out.

A1 – McDonald said that they are currently working on getting plans to change it out. The schedule is being finalized currently. He said that it would take about a week or so to change it over.

Adjournment:

Gates moved, McDonald 2nd, to adjourn at 6:56 pm.
