## Call to Order:

This regular meeting was called to order at 6:35 pm by McDonald.

## **Approve Minutes From Regular Meeting Held November 13, 2018:**

## <u>Discuss State of Connecticut minimum budget requirements (MBR) for Deep River</u> <u>Elementary School:</u>

McDonald explained that he had received a letter from the State Department of Education that states that Deep River has reduced its contribution to the complete (K-12) budget by more than allowed by the State. The State's formula has determined that Deep River is currently in non-compliance by \$68,487, and that is the amount that the State is requiring Deep River to provide the Board of Education with before the end of fiscal year 2018-2019. If the Town decides not to do so, Deep River's ECS grant funding will be reduced by \$136,974. McDonald explained that both he and Dr. Levy had been in communication with the State and that a continued conversation will take place in order to argue our case.

Both Gates and Burdick stated their dismay over the fact that the BoE and BoF had worked hard to reduce the budget without cutting programs. Gates questioned whether the Town and the School could withstand the described reduction in funding.

McDonald explained that if the money was put back into the budget, it might go toward improvements in security and heating efficiencies, money that will be spent anyway, but that had yet to be determined.
