Call to Order:

This regular meeting was called to order at 6:37 pm by McDonald.

Add items to the agenda:

Gates moved, Burdick 2nd, to add 2 items to the agenda. As item 4, discuss and act on Tax Collector refunds and as item 5, discuss and act on appointment of Sarah Ficca to the Parks and Recreation Commission & Auditorium Management Committee.

<u>Discuss and possible action on Emergency Management Director appointment - Matt Herman:</u>

McDonald introduced that the current Emergency Management Director, Jerry Clark, Sr., has been spending winter in Florida and expressed an interest in stepping back from the Directors position. McDonald noted that Mr. Clark has been working, even from Florida, in the position, but that Matt Herman had been recommended for the role by former EMD Keith Nelson. Mr. Herman is currently a member of both the Fire Dept. and the Ambulance Association and has been involved in emergency services for eleven years.

Burdick moved, Gates 2nd, to name Matt Herman Deep River's Emergency Management Director.

Tax Collector reimbursements:

McDonald stated that the Tax Collector has submitted a list of refunds to be disbursed totaling \$6,350.03, 5/6 of which is a payment to CT Solar Lease 2 as a result of a prolonged legal argument over taxability.
