

**CONSERVATION AND INLAND WETLANDS COMMISSION

A regular meeting of the *Deep River Conservation and Inland Wetlands Commission* held on Thursday, August 12, 2010 at the Deep River Town Hall was called to order at 7:33 p.m. by Chairman Mizejeski. Members present: George Atwood, Susan Board, Carol Libby, Alan Mizejeski. Absent: Carmela Balducci, Ron Larsen, John Szymanski, Alternate Michael Tomlinson, and Alternate/WEO Mark Reyher. Also present: Nancy Howard and Samuel Shaw.

Approval of Minutes: A motion was made by Susan Board and seconded by Alan Mizejeski to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of June 10, 2010 as printed. (4-0) Voted Unanimously.

Samuel Shaw, 52 West Elm Street (Map 51, Lot 42): An application was received from Samuel Shaw for the purpose of construction of a drainage system through his property at 52 West Elm Street. Mr. Shaw noted that there was an old drainage system established on the former Tiley property, two properties to the West of his property. The adjacent property directly to the West started having flooding problems and water in the basement. The water collects in Mr. Shaw's back field. The adjacent neighbor dug a 4'x4' trench directing the water flow from his property to the Shaw property. The trench has since collapsed and it is now point discharging. Mr. Shaw presented photographs of the trench and the flowing water. His property in the back cannot be accessed when it is wet. The plan for the proposal was prepared by Nathan Jacobson & Associates. Mr. Shaw proposes to create a ditch approximately 2'x2' and approximately 80 feet long. A small machine would be used for the activity. Mr. Shaw noted that silt fencing will be installed on the downhill side. The Commission requested that the sedimentation and erosion control measures be added to the plan. Mr. Shaw also noted that he proposes to include a clean out box. A motion was made by George Atwood and seconded by Carol Libby to accept the application by Samuel Shaw as essentially complete with the addition of the sedimentation and erosion control measures to the plan. (4-0) Voted Unanimously.

Enforcement: Alan Mizejeski noted that the letter was sent to Haynes Materials asking that a representative of the company attend a Commission meeting to discuss the erosion and sedimentation control measures at the Deep River Haynes site.

Financial Report/Payment of Bills: The following bills were received: Nancy Howard, clerical services, 10 ½ hours; and Hartford Courant, legal advertising, \$19.80. A motion was made by Carol Libby and seconded by Susan Board to approve payment of the bills as submitted. (4-0) Voted Unanimously.

Correspondence: A copy of a permit dated June 29, 2010 was received from DEP Office of Long Island Sound Programs to Jessica Waldman and Carl Thompson for regulated activities in a private boat basin off the Conn. River off property located at 38 Brockway Ferry Road.

Conservation: Alan Mizejeski referenced a newspaper article regarding an "adopt a spot" program established in Westbrook.

A motion was made by George Atwood and seconded by Susan Board to adjourn at 8:03 p.m. (4-0) Voted Unanimously.
