A **regular meeting** of the *Deep River Conservation and Inland Wetlands Commission* held on Thursday, July 9, 2015 at the Deep River Town Hall was called to order at 7:50 p.m. by Chairman Mizejeski. Members present: George Atwood, Alan Mizejeski, Ron Larsen, and Alternate Michael Tomlinson. Absent: Susan Board, John Dube, Carol Libby, Tanner Steeves, Alternate/WEO Mark Reyher. Also present: Nancy Howard and Jonathan Knox. Chairman seated Michael Tomlinson for an absent member.

Approval of Minutes: A motion was made by George Atwood and seconded by Mike Tomlinson to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of June 11, 2015 with the following amendment under Robert Garthwaite, 7 Main Street: Amend motion to read as follows: "Motion was made by Mike Tomlinson and seconded by George Atwood to determine that the activity does not require a permit since there is no grading or soil disturbance." (4-0) Voted Unanimously.

A motion was made by Mike Tomlinson and seconded by George Atwood to amend agenda item #3a to correct the applicant as Jonathan Knox. (4-0) Voted Unanimously.

Jonathan Knox, 426 Winthrop Road (Map 20, Lot 11-2): An application was received from Jonathan Knox for a garage addition with master bedroom at 426 Winthrop Road. Mr. Knox noted that a permit issued in 2004 included construction of home and garage. The garage was the only portion not yet constructed and the permit has since expired. Mr. Knox noted that he would like to proceed with the construction of the garage addition with master bedroom. He noted that the garage is approximately 75 feet from the wetlands. Commission members reviewed the file and the plan presented dated January 3, 2006. Permit No. 14-04 was issued on November 4, 2004 and expired in 2014. A motion was made by George Atwood and seconded by Mike Tomlinson to authorize the Wetlands Enforcement Officer to issue an administrative permit to Jonathan Knox for the construction of the garage. (4-0) Voted Unanimously.

Chairman Report: Chairman Mizejeski noted that he received a call regarding work being done with an excavator on the Deep River Farms property on West Elm Street. The caller was advised that the work was exempt on the farm for care of the irrigation pond.

A motion was made by George Atwood and seconded by Ron Larsen to adjourn at 8:18 p.m. (4-0) Voted Unanimously.
