  - 3. Design, copying, mailing of invitations for Re-opening program
  - 4. Program for Opening (layout, printing)

Decisions Made: Wednesday, May 1, 2013—Re-Dedication Ceremony Saturday, May 4, 2013-----Community-wide Open House

Follow-up: Claudia Epright volunteered to research town policy regarding consumption of alcoholic beverages on town property.
