- 1. A **regular meeting** of the *Deep River Planning and Zoning Commission* held on Thursday, May 19, 2016 at the Deep River Town Hall was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Chairman Bruce Edgerton. - 2. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>: A motion was made by Jane Samuels and seconded by Janet Edgerton to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of April 21, 2016 as printed. Voted Unanimously.
- 3. <u>Payment of Bills</u>: An invoice was received from Nancy Howard for clerical services for 40 hours. A motion was made by Jane Samuels and seconded by Janet Edgerton to approve payment of the invoice as received. Voted Unanimously.
- 4. <u>Correspondence</u>: ZEO Jefferson noted that a letter dated May 2, 2016 was received from John Vogt withdrawing the application for an accessory apartment at 82 Westbrook Road. Secretary Janet Edgerton noted receipt of the following correspondence: (a) letter dated May 9, 2016 from Attorney David Tycz confirming that he has been engaged to represent the Commission; and (b) letter dated May 12, 2016 from Attorney Tycz noting that the brief on behalf of the Commission has been filed regarding the appeal by Ronald Prisley.
