- 2. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>: The agenda was amended to eliminate approval of public hearing minutes because a public hearing was not held in January. A motion was made by Bill Burdick and seconded by Janet Edgerton to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of January 19, 2017 as printed. Voted Unanimously.
